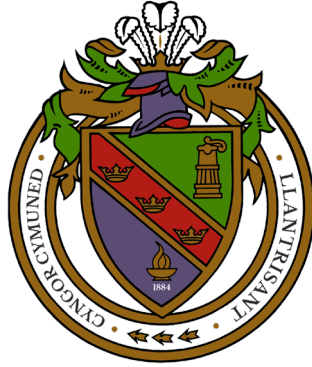

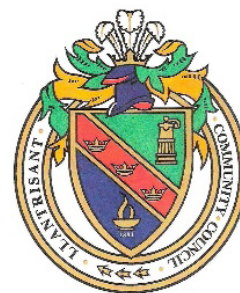

Temporary Staff Cover

- (i) that from 18th September 2023 for a period up to 2nd January 2024 the Clerk be authorised to engage temporary staff to cover the Deputy Clerk during her convalescence from medical treatment;

Temporary Appointment of Responsible Financial Officer

- (ii) that for the period from 2nd October 2023 up to 2nd January 2024, or until the Deputy Clerk returns to work, whichever is the sooner, that the Clerk to the Council act as the Responsible Financial Officer of the Council;

Correspondence was received from a local representative of the Child Leukaemia Foundation requesting a suggestion for the installation of a clothes bank in the area. It was **agreed** to reply with a suggestion of the car park at Beddau and Tynant Community Library.

REPORT OF THE CLERK
COMMUNITY GRANT ALLOCATIONS 2023

1. Llantrisant Community Council has budgeted to make available £23,000 in community grants to support community groups in the Community Council area, or organisations who may not be based in the area but provide valuable services which benefit our residents.
2. There are three funds, £10,000 for Beddau and Tynant, £11,000 for Llantrisant/Talbot Green and £2,000 in a General Grants fund (which we commonly refer to as the Umbrella Fund).
3. Ordinarily, applications for grants are open from the end of August until 30th September, and are done by the community group filling in a form which outlines among other things, the reason for applying for the grant, and which is returned to the Clerk accompanied by a statement of the organisation's financial situation.
4. The applications are then presented to full Council, ordinarily in October, where Members consider the applications and determine the allocation of funds upon the merit of the applications.
5. Should Members decide, some of the budgeted grant funds may be left unspent in October in order to make room to consider any late applications for financial assistance which may come in from time to time throughout the remainder of the municipal year.
6. The application process for 2023 has now concluded, and attached as Appendices I to III to this report is a headline summary of the applications received and the amount each organisation is requested, broken down by fund.
7. The detailed applications are available for Members' inspection from the Parish Office.

8. Members are asked to consider the applications and determine the allocations for 2023.

AO/23-24/13 Declarations of Interest

Cllr Anne Callow declared a non-pecuniary interest in relation to Minute AO/23-24/16, as a Trustee of Beddau, Llantrisant and Talbot Green Food Bank.

AO/23-24/14 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The Minutes of the meeting of the Assets and Operations Committee held on 7th June, which had been received and the recommendations contained considered by Council on 13th June 2023, were **approved** as a true record.

AO/23-24/15 Schedule of Major Works 2023

It was **agreed** to note the Schedule of Major Works of the Council.

AO/23-24/16 Beddau Community Centre (Adoption of Functions)

The Committee received the report of the Clerk in respect of discussions with Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council in respect of the future management of Beddau Community Centre.

Mr Mike Cude, speaking for Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council, stated that if the Community Council were minded to take on the management functions and responsibilities of the Centre, no historic debts would be passed on to the Council by RCTCBC. The Community Council would be expected to meet the cost of the electricity and gas supply, the cleaning of the hall and minor maintenance only. The fabric of the building, major capital works, insurances, non-domestic rates, water, health and safety matters etc., would be reserved as the responsibility of Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council.

Having considered the options put forward in the Clerk's report, and the discussion with Mr Cude, the Committee **agreed** unanimously to recommend to Council the following:

- (I) that Llantrisant Community Council take on, by agreement with Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council the following functions and responsibilities:
 - (i) to manage and control Beddau Community Centre for the social, educational, recreational and cultural activities for the benefits of the inhabitants of Beddau, Tynant and its adjoining area;
 - (ii) to meet the cost, through hiring charges or otherwise, of the wages of the cleaner and the electricity and gas supply;
 - (iii) to set a scale of charges for use of the Centre and its facilities estimated to produce income together with any additional income the Council may raise to meet the annual expenditure;
 - (iv) to keep the interior of the Centre in a reasonable condition, fair wear and tear excepted. Any works of maintenance or decorating to the interior must be carried out to the satisfaction of RCTCBC's appropriate officer. RCTCBC, or their duly appointed officer, shall have the power at all times, with reasonable notice, to inspect the Centre.
- (II) to align the oversight, scrutiny and exercise of those functions and responsibilities in respect of Beddau Community Centre with the Council's other assets and operations; and therefore
- (III) further recommend to Council that those functions and responsibilities which it has agreed to adopt be delegated to the Assets and Operations Committee of the Council; and therefore amend the Terms of Reference of the Assets and Operations Committee to reflect its new responsibilities and functions, namely to add the following:

“the exercising pro tempore of certain functions and responsibilities to manage and control Beddau Community Centre on behalf of Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council.”

LLANTRISANT

- (i) The Committee noted the Clerk's report which set out the plans for the weekend Christmas event in Llantrisant between 8th and 10th December 2023.
