GENERAL SHOW RULES

- 1 The hall will open at 7am for the staging of exhibits.
- 2 The hall will be cleared at 11am of all persons other than the judges and those authorised by the committee.
- 3 Exhibitors must stage their own exhibit. There are no restrictions as to place of residence. The show is open to all who wish to exhibit.
- 4 All produce must have been grown by the exhibitor. If in the opinion of the judges this is not so, then these entries will be disqualified.
- 5 All art and craft exhibits must have been created solely by the exhibitor within 12 months of the show. The Committee reserves the right to satisfy itself that this condition is observed.
- 6 All photographs must be taken by the exhibitor. If in the opinion of the judges the photograph has been altered or created by AI, then these entries will be disqualified.
- 7 No child exhibitor will be allowed to stage more than one exhibit in each class.
- 8 Exhibitors must provide their own containers for all exhibits.
- 9 The judges are empowered to withhold any prizes if, in their opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
- 10 All cup and trophy winners will be required to sign a written guarantee for the safe return of such cups/trophies by **no later than 30th July the following year.**
- 11 Whilst all reasonable care will be taken, officers and the committee cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to exhibits or property.
- 12 Exhibitors, please note: Class 25, 26 and 27 must have a minimum of 2 inches/50mm of stem with no roots left on.
- 13 Wherever possible, exhibitors should name varieties, as this makes the show more interesting and informative for everyone.
- 14 No entries will be accepted on the day of the show.
